The 40th course: July 11 – August 9

The Summer School of Slavonic Studies at the Faculty of Arts of Palacký University in Olomouc (LŠSS FF UP) organizes courses of Czech language designated for teachers, lectors and students of Czech language and literature, Slavonic studies, translators, journalists, businessmen and applicants from the general public interested in Czech language, literature and culture. The programme comprises of courses for beginners (A0) as well as advanced learners (C1).

Our students receive a certificate of their language level at the end of the course based on results from the final test. Students that do not pass the final test or do not attend the whole course obtain a confirmation of their participation at LŠSS FF UP.

Since 2018, our summer school course has been certified in the ECTS system and students who meet the given requirements are entitled to 8 ECTS credits back at their home university.

Courses at Summer School of Slavonic Languages FF UP are primarily designated for adults (minimum of 18 years of age).

We offer three types of courses to self-payers:

- > four-week course: July 11 – August 9, 2026
- > two-week course: July 11 – July 26, 2026
- > two-week course: July 25 – August 9, 2026*

* Please be aware that students of this term will be incorporated into classes that will be already open. It is therefore not recommended for absolute beginners.

All information about the conditions for admission and deadlines will be provided by the relevant embassy or consulate of the Czech Republic.

The list of countries eligible for the scholarship at LSS FF UP in 2026: Austria, Belgium, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Denmark, Egypt, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, China, Italy, Japan, Norway, Poland, Romania, Serbia and Montenegro, Slovakia, Spain, Taiwan, UK, Ukraine, USA, Vietnam.

If you wish to participate at Summer School in Olomouc, please indicate it in the application form – otherwise you could be assigned another Summer School.

Summer School of Slavonic Studies FF UP does not award the scholarship and does not take part in the admission procedure.

Successful candidates will be notified via e-mail in spring (April/May 2026).

We offer just one course type to the scholarship holders:

- four-week course: July 11 – August 9, 2026



Programme

Course fee includes:

- › intensive Czech language course – 100 contact lessons in total: 20 teaching days, 5 lessons per day (study groups of 12 students maximum),
- › study materials (coursebooks according to the given language level),
- › course of corrective pronunciation,
- › workshops (e.g. translation, conversation, writing, grammar, ...),
- › lectures and seminars (Czech language, literature, history, culture, ...),



- › cultural programme and other activities,
- › weekend trips,
- › film club,
- › folklore evening with a traditional Moravian dulcimer band,
- › dance workshop: lessons in traditional Czech and Moravian folklore dances,
- › choir singing,
- › sport activities,
- › Summer School campfire etc.

Venue, accommodation, board

Venue

Renovated building of the Faculty of Arts, Palacký University, Křížkovského 10, Olomouc.

Equipped with: modern classrooms, Wi-Fi connection in the whole building, study rooms with PCs, relax zone as a part of the historical gardens, lockers, Fresh-UP bistro and drinks dispensers, university library right next to the venue.

Accommodation

Students of LŠSS can stay at the university dormitory – Generála Svobody dormitory (address: Šmeralova 12, Olomouc, 10 minute walk from the Faculty of Arts).

- › double rooms, i.e. 2 students in one room (toilet and bathroom shared with the neighbouring room)
- › individual accommodation in a double room, i.e. just 1 student in a room (toilet and bathroom shared with the neighbouring room)

The following is provided: bed linen, towels, internet connection, shared kitchen on the floor, washing machine (paid service).

The scholarship of the Czech Ministry of Education covers accommodation in double rooms. In case the scholarship holders require an individual accommodation, they have to mark that in the application, and they have to pay the price for individual room via bank transfer to the bank account of LŠSS or pay in cash.

Board

LŠSS students can take advantage of many cafés and restaurants in Olomouc (for breakfasts, lunches, dinners). The scholarship holders will receive meal coupons for lunches and dinners valid in restaurants near the university offering a wide range of meals (also vegetarian) of Czech and international cuisine.

Scholarship holders

The scholarship of the Czech Ministry of Education covers:

- › course fee,
- › board (meal coupons),
- › accommodation in a double room (in case the scholarship holders want an individual accommodation, they have to mark that in the application, and they have to pay the price for individual room via bank transfer to the bank account of LŠSS or pay in cash – 3.500 CZK).

Self-payers

The price for the course is indicated in two currencies: in euros (EUR) and Czech crowns (CZK) – the price includes the city fee (50 CZK/person/night).

Payment information and discounts

Payment information

The payment of the course fee and the accommodation is to be paid via bank transfer **no later than June 30, 2026**. You can make the payment in euros (EUR) or Czech crowns (CZK).

Note! You should make the payment with regard to the right account: payments in EUR are to be sent to the EUR account, payments in CZK are to be sent to the CZK account. All bank transfer fees are to be covered by the applicant.

Discounts for self-payers in 2026

This year we offer two types of discounts for our self-payers, each for one course type:

- 30 EUR or 750 CZK per applicant and course fee – provided that all due fees are paid by May 1, 2026,
- 60 EUR or 1.500 CZK per applicant and course fee – this applies for returning students who participated in our summer school between 2006–2025 either as a scholarship holder or a self-payer.

If applicable, you can ask for both the discounts at a time!

Conditions

In order to ask for the discount either/both the conditions need to be met and the applicant has to cover all fees connected with bank transfers (see the information about the payment).
